

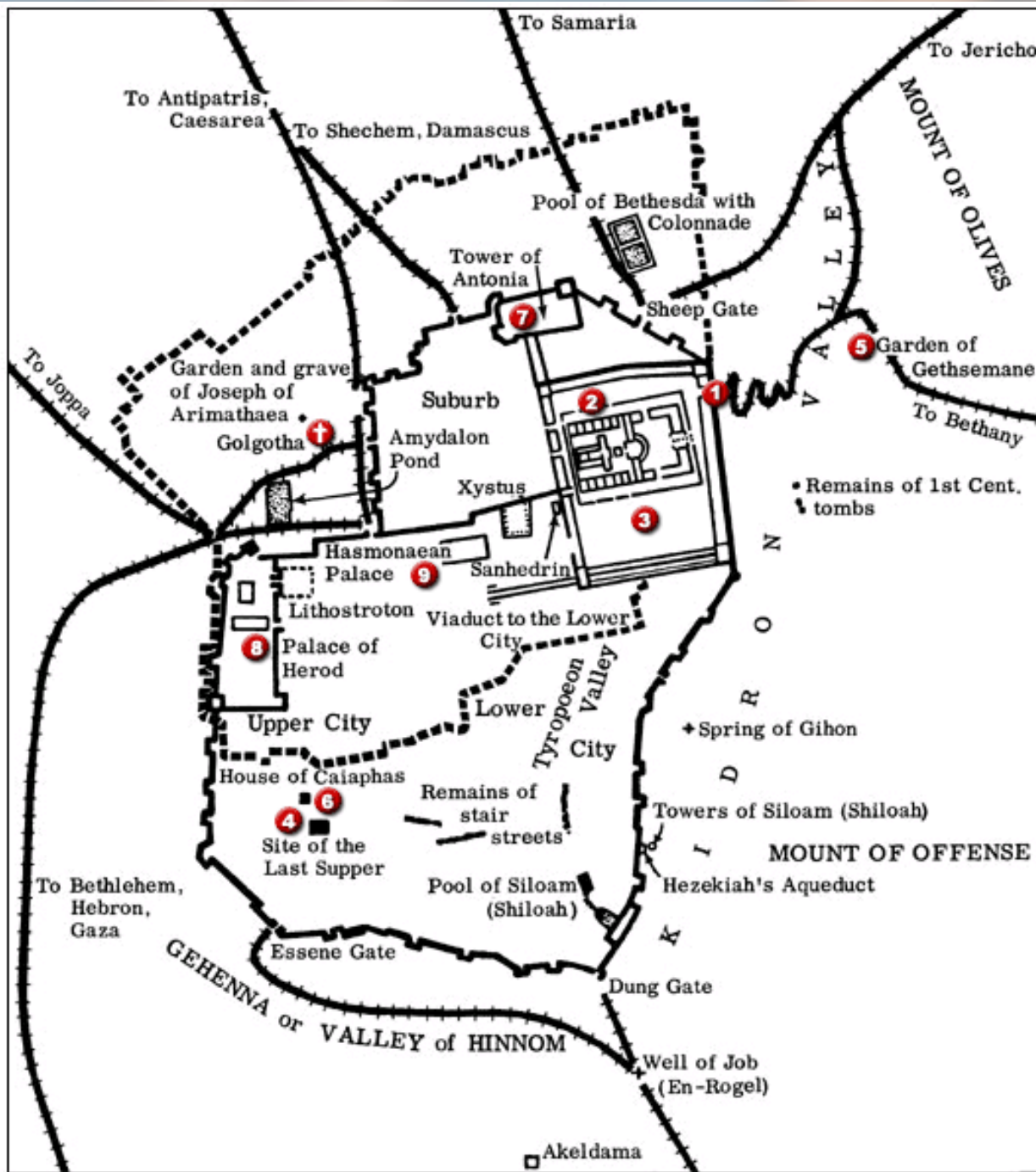
# LOOKING AT SCRIPTURE

- **The context of the text –**
  - ❖ Who wrote the text? When? Where? For whom? What were his concerns/the theological meanings he wished to convey?
  - ❖ Who are the people and events in the text? What is the religious world of the text? What is the social/cultural world of the text?
  - ❖ Where did the text take place?
  - ❖ What did particular words, images or expression mean at the time the text was written?
- **The structure of the text –**
  - ❖ What is the genre? What techniques are characteristic of that genre and how are they deployed in the text?
  - ❖ What are the ways the author attempts to influence feelings, ideas and expectations in the text?
- **The “so what?” of the text –**
  - ❖ What does this text mean for believers?

1 The Golden Gate – Jesus enters Jerusalem on a donkey.

2 The Temple – Jesus enters the Temple compound.

9 Hasmonaean Palace - Herod delivers Jesus to Pontius Pilate to stand trial.
